100 Points Rummy

100 Points Rummy is a card game in the 100 Points line of games that uses 100 Points cards.

Overview

100 Points Rummy is a simple card game where players try to get a **four-card hand totaling 100 points**. Each time they do, they score the hand. The first player with 400 points wins the game.

The game can be played with 2 or more players.

You will need 1 set of 100 Points cards **per player** to play this game.

Pre-game Setup

Before play, shuffle 1 set of 100 Points cards per player together. A full set of cards consists of:

- Seven 10 Point cards
- Four 20 Point cards
- Seven 30 Point cards
- Four 40 Point cards
- Two 50 Point Cards

Place the shuffled cards face down in the middle of the table to form the Draw pile.

Choose a player to go first.

Have each player draw 4 cards for their starting hand.

Game Rules

On a player's turn they may either **Draw & Discard** or **Score & Refresh**.

Draw & Discard

If a player chooses to Draw & Discard, they draw the top card from either the Draw or the Discard pile, and add it to their hand. Then, the player places a card from their hand face-up on the top of the Discard pile. This ends the player's turn.

Score & Refresh

If all four cards in a player's hand total exactly 100 points, then they may Score & Refresh. To Score & Refresh, place all four cards face-up for the other players to see. Place the cards off to the side in a personal Score pile, and draw 4 more cards from the top of the Draw pile. This ends the player's turn.

If at any time a player goes to draw a card and there are no cards in the Draw pile, gather the cards in the Discard pile, shuffle them, and place them face down to create a new Draw pile.

Once a player is done with their turn (assuming there's no winner), the player to their left takes their turn.

Game Over

The game ends when one player has 400 points in their Score pile at the end of their turn.

Misc. Rules and Etiquette

- In order to score points, a player must have exactly 100 Points in their hand. No more. No less.
- Only draw from the top of the Draw or Discard pile.
- To avoid confusion, feel free to verbally declare your action on your turn.

Single-Player Rules

Want to play a solitaire game? No problem, all of the rules to the normal game apply, except two:

- Never draw from the Discard pile, only the Draw pile.
- Do not shuffle the Discard pile to make a new Draw pile once the cards run out.

If you score 400 points before the Draw pile runs out, you win.

Tournament Rules

To play a tournament game of 100 Points Rummy, keep score for each player on a pad of paper. When a player gets 400 points to end a game, write down how many points each player has in their Score pile. Start a new game with a different player starting the game, and score the game as above.

Once each player at the table has had a chance to start a game, the tournament is over. The player with the most total points wins the tournament.
